



## What's Saga Airport like?

## Why do you need to extend the runway?



The foreign airlines that currently service our airport are requesting an extension in order to further improve our safety conditions. Many overseas airports have runways longer than 2,500m, and there are limits regarding pilots and planes when it comes to 2,000m runways like the one at Saga Airport.



## How will extending the runway benefit us?



The foreign airlines that currently service our airport will be able to more safely use our runway, which means we can increase the number of flights and destinations. As such, we can welcome more foreign guests that contribute to a livelier town! We can help internationalize Saga and southwestern Fukuoka! It'll be easier for us to travel abroad too!




## How are you going to extend it?



We're considering plans to extend the runway to the East and a plan to extend it in both directions. If we take all of the financial and environmental factors into account, we think that the plan to extend it 500m to the East looks like the best choice!
