

## Don't Forget!

To residents within the UPZ (approx. 5-30km radius away from the nuclear plant)

Sheltering indoors during a nuclear disaster is the first step to staying safe



If a state of Alert is issued, firstly collect your children from school, return home and listen to the TV etc. for information while staying indoors.



In a nuclear disaster, it is important to stay calm and await correct information and instructions from public authorities.

## Staying in the home, "Sheltering indoors," is the first step to staying safe.\*

\* Going outdoors can greatly increase your risk of exposure if radioactive material is somehow released from the nuclear power plant. Keep this booklet where it can be clearly

\* If everyone tries to evacuate far away all at once, this can lead to confusion and accidents, thus leading to increased risks.
